Shear a llama (and a sheep!) - Saturday March 12th - 9.00am - Join us on Saturday morning, after our regular animal feeding, as we shear Top Deck the llama and Spics our sheep. See how traditional shearing is performed and take home some llama wool.

Balingup Ghost Walk - Saturday March 12th - 7.30pm - Join Balingup locals as they take you on a guided tour of the town. Here you'll meet 'ghosts' and hear them tell stories of local personalities who lived in Balingup between 1855 and 1955. Learn about the hardships they endured and be entertained by tales of the social life they enjoyed, in a fun and interactive way. Leave from the Packing Shed in the Centre of town, the distance walked is less than 2 km and most of the terrain is flat. There are some gravel surfaces so you need to wear enclosed shoes. Bring a torch.

Fruit Picking - Sunday March 13th - 11.00am - Join Diane from Spring Valley Orchard and learn what it takes to get fruit from the orchard to the table. You'll have the opportunity to 'pick your own' and also do a tour of the orchard. There'll be plenty of samples!
